



What is BYOD?

Bring your own device (BYOD) refers to technology models where students bring a personally owned device to school for learning. A personally owned device is any technology device brought into the school and owned by a student (or the student's family), staff or guest. **Laptop computers** are the UHS preferred devices for all students as they have the capability to run most software programs required at school.

Why is UHS a BYOD school?

It is widely acknowledged that technology plays a huge role in students' everyday lives and should, therefore, be an integral part of their learning. At UHS, classrooms are embedded with the BYOD initiative to encourage our 21st Century students to build their capacity to become active, collaborative, and selfmotivated global learners.

What device do students need to bring?

If your child already has a laptop, we encourage them to bring it to school. However, if you are looking at purchasing a new device, we strongly encourage that a laptop is purchased as it has more functionality than a tablet.
