Dear Parents,

Milton Ulladulla Apex Club are seeking expressions of interest from parents to attend our upcoming community camps for high school students aged between 12-14 in our local area as a means of building resilience and connections. We have received funding to run this camp from our national foundation as a response to the bushfire season of 2019-20 and has become even more relevant across the past 2 years spent dealing with COVID-19.

In putting this camp on we wanted to choose a local campground with access to a range of outdoor activities including bike riding on nearby tracks and beach games across the weekend. The boys will also be asked to cook dinner for the group (with assistance and access to quality local ingredients) on the Saturday evening before finishing the weekend on a positive note with a yoga session and boys growth workshop delivered by Dean Dampney of Nature Mind (<http://www.naturemind.com.au>) on the Sunday morning.

All expenses for camping, food and activities will be covered for all attendees across the weekend (boys, parents and siblings).
