



Ulladulla High School

Enrolment Policy

This policy is to be viewed in conjunction with the Education reform Act 1990.

1. Ulladulla High School will enrol any eligible student within the designated local intake area. Students with special needs will have those needs assessed and appropriate supports established prior to enrolment being accepted.
2. Based on permanent accommodation at the school, ceiling of 1220 student is the maximum number of enrolments.
3. Before the ceiling of 1220 students is reached, applications for non-local enrolments will be considered on the basis of the following criteria:
 - Learning and wellbeing needs requiring reasonable adjustments and/or additional education support, including cultural considerations, disability, development age, trauma, child protection concerns, medical and individual needs and circumstances
 - Sibling currently attending the school
 - Parent or carer works at the school
 - Proximity and access to the school
 - Structure and organisation of the school
 - Safety and supervision of the student before and after school
 - Availability of subjects or combinations of subject
 - Other considerations
4. After the ceiling of 1220 students is reached, non-local applications will not be considered unless there are extreme and extenuating circumstances relating to the criteria listed above.
5. A placement panel will consider all applications from non-local enrolments. The placement panel will consist of the Principal, relevant Deputy Principal and a P&C elected parent representative.
6. A waiting list will be established for non-local applicants. This list will be current for one year.
7. Parents may appeal against the decision of the panel. This should be done in writing to the Principal.
