In English we aim to foster in students a love of language and literature. Students will experience a wide range of literary and non-literary texts and will develop skills in creating, responding sensitively to, deconstructing and critically evaluating these texts. These include written, spoken, visual representation, creative and analytical writing, and contextual research.
